

**LMIS Sub Group Meeting for devising codes
Record of Discussions**

Date & Time: 11th December 2013 (11:00 AM - 01:30 PM)

Venue: NDCC-II (9th Floor), Jai Singh Road, New Delhi

The Director General, NSDA welcomed all the sub group members and gave a recap of the first meeting of the Steering Committee on LMIS held on 25th October 2013 chaired by the Chairman, NSDA in which this sub group was formed as part of the key decisions of the meeting. He mentioned the specific tasks allocated to the sub group. Following key decisions/ action items were identified in the meeting:

1. NSDC presented the details of the process being adopted by them for alignment of QP- NOS and National Classifications of Occupation (NCO-2004). Currently out of 367 QPs notified so far, 195 QPs have been identified to have linkage and are mapped to NCO-2004. NSDC would further provide the details of 172 non-aligned QPs along with the reasons. **[Action Item: NSDC]**
2. ILO presented the work done by them so far in this connection. It was found in course of discussions that NCO-2004 (which is based on ISCO 1988) may be outdated, and there is need to update the same in accordance with International Standard Classification of Occupations (ISCO)-2008. NSDA would write letter to Directorate General of Education and Training (DGET) requesting them to initiate the process for the same. **[Action Item: NSDA and DGET]**
3. Presentation was made by Ministry of Rural Development on how they are trying to map NIC codes, NCO codes and QP-NOS for courses under Aajeevika Skills Project Application, which was analyzed by sub-group members.
4. Further to the above, discussions were made to derive the mechanism for mapping the NIC Codes and NCO Codes, that could be adopted by all the ministries and departments of the Government of India, as well as the Sector Skill Councils. Looking from the Skilling perspective, one way to formulate the mapping code could be undertaken by restricting the NIC Code to its initial 3 digits (corresponding to Division and Group) and the remainder to be derived by NCO code. This code should then be able to automatically throw SSC QP as

the outcome. This methodology would be discussed in the next Steering Committee meeting.

5. It was agreed that Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) should be made part of this sub group. **[Action Item: NSDA]**

Meeting ended with a vote of thanks to all the sub-group members.
