**Notice**

The 'Guidelines for Recognition and Regulation of Awarding Bodies' and 'Guidelines for Recognition and Regulation of Assessment Agencies' have been launched by the Hon'ble Minister of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship on October 27, 2020.

As per the government mandate, NCVET recognition is binding for any Awarding Body and Assessment Agency implementing government funded training programs. However, a transition period of maximum one year will be provided to all existing Awarding Bodies & Assessment Agencies empanelled with them.

All such bodies are requested to seek NCVET recognition within 6 months, as per the Guidelines, to enable NCVET to process their application before the expiry of transition period. All new Awarding Bodies and Assessment Agencies may apply as per the Guidelines
