

18th Meeting of the National Skills Qualifications Committee (NSQC)

The 18th meeting of the National Skills Qualifications Committee (NSQC) was held on October 09, 2017 at NSDA, New Delhi. Shri K.P. Krishnan, Chairman, NSDA and Secretary, MoSDE chaired the meeting. The list of participants is at Annexure I.

Agenda Item I: To confirm the minutes of the 17th Meeting of NSQC

1.1 The Committee approved the minutes of the 17th NSQC meeting.

Agenda Item II: Action Taken Report on the minutes of the 17th NSQC

2.1 The Committee noted the action taken on the minutes on the 17th NSQC meeting and advised the following:-

- a.) NSDA to undertake discussion w.r.t. on flexibility on adoption of Qualification Pack (QP)/National Occupation Standard (NOS) with National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) and submit its report to Chairman, NSDA.
- b.) NSDA may prepare a calendar for review of qualifications. The time period required for successful roll out of any job role can be considered as minimum period for review of existing qualifications.
- c.) A sub-committee under the chairmanship of DG, NSDA be constituted to review and reconcile the difference of opinion among various stakeholders in finalizing the qualifications and place them before the NSQC. DG, NSDA is authorized to nominate members to this sub-committee and take final decision regarding placement of such qualifications files for consideration and approval of NSQC.

(Action: NSDA)

Agenda Item III: Progress on NSQF operationalization

3.1 DG, NSDA provided an update on the action taken on NSQF implementation. The Committee advised that NSDA should prepare a database of state-wise skill development schemes and map the alignment of such schemes with respect to NSQF. A similar database with respect to all the Central Ministries and Departments should also be prepared.

qualifications which have job roles similar in SSC and any other Submitting Bodies. DG, NSDA to nominate other members in the committee.

4.9 A Sub Committee under DG, NSDA was formed with representation from DGT, relevant SSC, relevant Ministries and MD, SSDM Rajasthan to re-align all the courses of DGT with NSQF and look into the consistency and the levels of Qualification. The Committee will complete the re-alignment process within the period of 4 weeks so that all such qualification files are placed in NSQC scheduled to be held in the first/second week of November 2017.

4.10 The Committee directed that a standard template should be used for placing of the Qualification Files before NSQC and levels of progression must be backed up by vocational training as a standard for all Qualifications. Information regarding stakeholder consultation must be incorporated in the template.

4.11 The name of the Qualification should link to the job role and reflect the same with proper mapping to National Classification of Occupation (NCO) & International Standard Classification of Occupation (ISCO) code.

4.12 NSDC suggested that the information captured in Qualification Files w.r.t. international equivalence should be shared with them and the same was accepted by the Committee.

4.13 Sector-specific observation of the Committee on the qualifications placed for consideration is as under:

4.13.1 Apparel:

MHRD raised the issue of duplication of QP for Fashion Designer since a similar QP with same title is already available at National Qualification Register (NQR). The Committee advised NSDA to review the duplication, if any and accordingly, the qualification be considered as approved.

4.13.2 Automotive:

M/o MSME was advised to consult all relevant stakeholders for the qualifications submitted to enhance opportunity for employment. It was also suggested that there is need to re-align MSME qualifications with SSCs. One Qualification file was approved.

4.13.3 Capital Goods:

02 Qualification Files were placed before NSQC and the same were approved. The Committee suggested that 'Rigger' title to be revised to make it more aspirational.

4.13.4 Leather:

A total of 05 Qualification Files were placed before NSQC and the same were approved. FDDI requested NSQC to consider them as one the assessment and certification body for the qualification submitted by M/o MSME. The Committee referred this matter to DG, NSDA.

4.13.5 Media:

A total of 06 Qualification Files, submitted by M/o MSME (4 QFs) and Additional Skills Acquisition Programme (ASAP), Govt. of Kerala (2), were placed and approved by NSQC.

4.13.6 Environment:

02 Qualification Files were presented by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change. Both files were approved by the Committee.

4.13.7 Electronics:

The Committee suggested to re-look the titles of jobroles and align them to an occupation in consonance with NCO 2015.

4.13.8 Sports:

01 Qualification File was placed before NSQC by M/o MSME and the same was approved by the Committee.

4.13.9 Chemicals and Petrochemicals:

The Committee accorded in-principle approval for all the 10 Qualification Files submitted by CIPET. However, DG, NSDA was authorized to decide the level and hierarchy of qualifications in consultation with DGT and CIPET.

4.13.10 Beauty & Wellness:

A total of 08 Qualification Files submitted by Beauty and Wellness SSC were placed before NSQC, out of which, 3 were revised qualifications i.e. Asst Beauty Therapist, Asst Hair Stylist and Pedicurist & Manicurist. All the qualifications were approved by NSQC. It was suggested by the Committee that the job roles of this sector should be made employable.

4.13.11 Construction:

A total of 19 Qualification Files were placed before NSQC: Out of 19 Qualifications, 16 Qualifications were submitted by the construction SSC, 02 Qualification by West Bengal Government and 01 by MoSME. The committee accorded in-principle approval to all.

The Construction SSC indicated that two Qualifications related to 'Plasma Cutter' and 'Draughtsman' were not placed by NSDA on account of duplication and emphasized that these are unique Qualifications. Chairman NSQC directed to initiate the consultation process with other SSCs w.r.t. these two qualifications under DG, NSDA and if required, the same may be placed in next NSQC meeting.

West Bengal: 02 Qualification Files from the state of West Bengal were placed and the same were approved. The qualification named 'Electrical Housewiring and Motor-Winding' which was placed before NSQC was approved subject to change of Qualification title and occupation.

M/o MSME: One Qualification File was placed before NSQC and the same was approved.

4.13.12 Domestic Worker:

04 Qualification Files were submitted. The Committee observed that there appears to be overlap with Hospitality sector and advised consultation with Hospitality, Health and concerned line Ministries. In case, there is no duplication, the qualifications are approved.

4.2.13 Hydrocarbons:

02 Qualification Files were submitted & both were approved. The committee suggested to re-look the NCO codes.

4.2.14 Infrastructure:

08 Qualification Files were submitted and all were approved.

4.2.15 Banking & Finance:

01 Qualification File placed before NSQC and was approved.

4.13.16 Handicrafts:

03 Qualification Files submitted by SSC were placed before NSQC and the same were approved.

4.2.13 Power:

05 Qualification Files were placed before NSQC and all approved.
